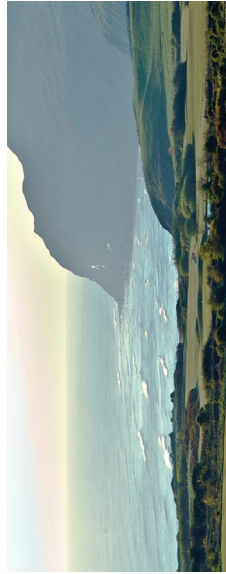

HUNLEY HOTEL & GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

The following Local Rules have been approved in accordance with and have the same standing as The Rules of Golf:

A-1 DEFINING BOUNDARIES- OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2)

The Following areas have been declared to be Out of Bounds.

- A). Any hedgerow, fence or line of white stakes on the perimeter of The General Area of The Course.
- B). The Driving Range (White Stakes) and Range Buildings.
- C). The Hotel and Club House Buildings and Car Parks and The Green Keepers Sheds and surrounds.
- D). The Practice Chipping Area (behind The Green keepers Sheds) and Practice Putting Green.

B-2 RELIEF ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF RED PENALTY AREA (RULE 17)

When a player's ball is in a penalty area, including when it is known or virtually certain to be in a penalty area even though not found, the player may take relief using one of the options under Rule 17.1d.

Or, when the ball last crossed the edge of the red penalty area on Cattersty/Cooks Endeavour, as an extra relief option adding one penalty stroke, the player may drop the original ball or another ball on the opposite side of the penalty area:

- **Reference Point:** The estimated point on the opposite edge of the penalty area that is the same distance from the hole as the estimated point where the original ball last crossed the edge of the red penalty area.
- **Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point:** Two club-lengths, but with these limits:
- **Limits on Location of Relief Area:**
Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and may be in any area of the course except the same penalty area, but if more than one area of the course is located within two club-lengths of the reference point, the ball must come to rest in the relief area in the same area of the course that the ball first touches when dropped in the relief area.

F-1 DEFINING ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS AND INTEGRAL OBJECTS (RULE 16)

- Ground under Repair is defined by any area encircled by a continuous white line.
- All fixed signage boards in The General Area are Immovable Obstructions.
- Winter Tee boxes (other than when in use) are Immovable Obstructions.
- Sprinkler Heads are Immovable Obstructions.

F-5 IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS (RULE 16.1)

The player also has these extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play:

Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is: On the line of play, and is:

- Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
- Within two club-lengths of the ball.

Exception - No Relief If Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

F-17 ALL ROADS AND PATHS TREATED AS OBSTRUCTIONS

All roads and paths on the course, even if not artificially-surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

J-1 METHODS FOR STOPPING AND RESUMING PLAY

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by a single siren blast, resumption of play will be signalled by a single siren blast. When Play is abandoned and Players must leave the course, the signal will be three separate siren blasts. See Rule 5.7b.

For the full text of any Model Local Rules referenced, please refer to the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf. Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a local rule is the General Penalty.
