



Dress Code

All players are required to wear recognisable golf attire when on the golf course and must not wear any clothing that may cause offence to other members, staff or visitors to the club.

Shirts must have a collar.

Sports shirts such as football shirts, rugby shirts, collarless t-shirts and sleeveless vest tops are not permitted.

Ladies may wear recognisable collared sleeveless golf shirts and if so designed may wear their shirts outside of their trousers, shorts, skirts and capris.

Trousers such as denim jeans, cargo pants, combat trousers and tracksuits are not acceptable when on the course.

Shorts may be worn however these should be knee length, tailored and be worn with socks (ankle/trainer socks are permitted).

Recognisable golf shoes, either spikeless or with soft spikes must be worn at all times when on the Golf Course.

Junior members and guests are encouraged to follow this dress code.
